

## Musical CD for KESaid

Many of the musical performances of the school have been recorded by Mr Hughes. With the help of some sixth formers the sound clips have been edited and are to be burnt onto a CD. The CD is to be sold and the profits will go to the School Charity (KESaid).

The CD needs a cover (both front and rear). Students have been asked to design it. There is a small prize for the winning design, plus the knowledge that their print will be part of the CD that is to be sold.

You may choose to use a mixture of the adobe programs to create your design (InDesign, Photoshop & Illustrator). The emphasis is on the quality of the final version, so be careful not to oversize pixel images as they may become “pixelated”, this is more likely to happen in Photoshop.

You may use existing images of Clipart. For example you might want to include a range of Musical instruments. These can be found in Resources > Subjects > InfoTech > Graphics+ > CLIPART. You may also use images related to KES again from the Graphics+ area. The only images you may use from the Internet are ones that relate to this year’s charity. The title should be displayed on the front cover. The Title is “KESaid: Music for xxxxxx”, where xxxxxx is the name of the Charity.

The front CD cover measures 12cm by 12cm, whilst the back is 14.5cm (Width) by 12 cm. The width includes 8mm which are folded at right angles to be displayed on the side edge. The side Edge must include the Title, as found on normal CD’s.

The Judges have been asked to provide a few examples of their favourite CD / Album covers. (see below).
